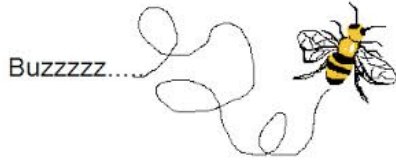


It's Great to Be a Wildcat!
