REGISTRATION INFORMATION

All registrants will be asked for two forms of residency upon registering. Forms of residency include but are not limited to a current water bill, utility bill, cable bill, or rental agreement.

Last day for mail in registration is June 30, 2012. On-site registration is August 9, 2012 from 7:00 AM to 1:00 PM and 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM in John F. Kennedy School Library.

Please be sure to make appointments with your doctor early for physicals and immunizations. A physical clinic will be held on August 9, 2012 from 9:00 AM-12:00 PM and 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM. The cost of the physical is \$25.00. Immunizations are NOT available at the clinic held at JFK.

The following are required at the listed grade levels:

- Kindergarten: Physical, dental, proof of immunizations
- Grade 2: dental
- Grade 6: physical, dental, proof of immunization

A sports physical is NOT acceptable for a school physical at grades Kindergarten, 6 and 9.

All students participating in extra-curricular sports must have a sports physical or school physical prior to try-outs.
