School resumes January 5th

Monday, January 5^{th} , school resumes from Winter break. In addition first semester ends on January 30^{th} . Student report cards will be issued on February 6^{th} . Please contact your child's teacher with any questions.

Reminders:

- Please **renew** 2nd semester bus passes and Kindergarten snack milk by Wednesday, January 21st. The semester bus fee is \$50, and milk for the second semester is \$26.25. Please note there are no waivers available for Kindergarten snack milk. Any questions please direct them to the office at 815-664-4601. Note: both of these fees must be paid in full.
- Please remember to call the offices by 9:00 a.m. if your child will not be attending school.
- During the cold and flu season, students must be fever free for a full 24 hours—without fever reducing medicine, before returning to school. Not only does this prevent the spread of germs, but protects your child from getting new ones or a relapse due to a compromised physical system.
- Remember your child will be outside before school and during recess, most days. Dressing in layers is suggested. Also, snow pants and boots are required to play on the equipment. We have many students who are forgetting winter coats, hats and gloves. Please make sure they have all the necessary gear when leaving for school.

- Please help keep our youngest students and their siblings safe by utilizing the required safety seats in your vehicles as required by Illinois law.

We are writing to inform you about a student survey that will be administered at your child's school called the Illinois 5Essentials Survey. This is the third year the Illinois State Board of Education will implement this survey across the state. This survey is based on 20 years of research at the University of Chicago. It asks students about their experiences in school, giving school leaders critical student input to help develop school improvement plans.

This year, student participants will be required to log-in using their student ID and birth date in order to complete the survey. Students' identities will be completely confidential. Teachers or administrators will never see individual responses to survey questions and will only receive aggregated information, such as the total percentage of students who agree homework assignments help them learn the course material.
