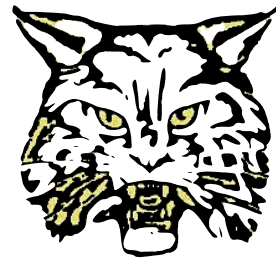

ELECTRONIC DEVICES
