Please help with the pick up/drop off process. Please note that you should not arrive any earlier than 15 minutes before school ends. All morning drop offs are at the main entrance off of Strong Street. (Glass vestibule) Pick up at night is at the main entrance for grades 3-8 and the south entrance at 3:15 pm after the buses leave for K-2 and any older siblings. Please do not block our neighbors in or out of their driveways. Also, bus riders need to have a valid bus pass. Soon bus drivers will be checking before school and staff will be checking after school. If you are in town, the cost is \$50 per semester. We only have full semester passes.
