Updates for the 2023-2024 school year:

Pick-up/Drop-off:

- Enter from Strong Avenue, then exit using North Richards Street.
- Students picked up on the south end should ride in the back seat and enter the vehicle from the driver side.
- All walkers and K/1st car riders and siblings will exit the south side at dismissal.

AM:

- Only bus riders and walkers are allowed on the south side.
- All students being dropped off will be dropped off in the north lot from 7:45 to 8:15 am. Pull up and when your vehicle is stopped between the front door and the north junior high door, have your child exit the vehicle.
- If you have a special circumstance where your child(ren) need(s) to be dropped off between 7:30-7:40 please contact the office for permission and directives.

PM:

- Bus riders are dismissed from class at 3:00 and 3:08 buses will depart JFK.
- 2nd through 8th grade students, who are car riders, will be picked up in the North Lot beginning at 3:15. (Unless they have a K/1 sibling then south side)
- Walkers & car riders will be dismissed at 3:15.
- K/1st car riders and older siblings will exit on the south side.
